YCT- Do you use any special ingredients?

Kate-My only special ingredient is love ...I love to bake and from that labor of love, I only use the best whole ingredients and the cookies are handmade from scratch and only made to order to ensure freshness.

YCT- What is the turnaround time for order cookies?

Kate-For large orders of more than 50 cookies I would like at least 10 days notice. However, I always encourage my clients to always call me even if its last minute as I will always try to accommodate them if possible.

YCT-Do you bake anything besides cookies?

Kate-Yes I love to make my delicious cupcakes from many of my numerous recipes. I have a lot of adorable and beautiful ideas for your special occasions.

YCT-What is the typical cost for specialty cookie favor?

Kate- The cost ranges from \$3.50-\$6.50; however they can run more or less depending upon the request, detail and size of the cookie. The cost of my cookie platters is \$14.99 per lb and they approximately have 15-18 smaller cookies.

Pirate



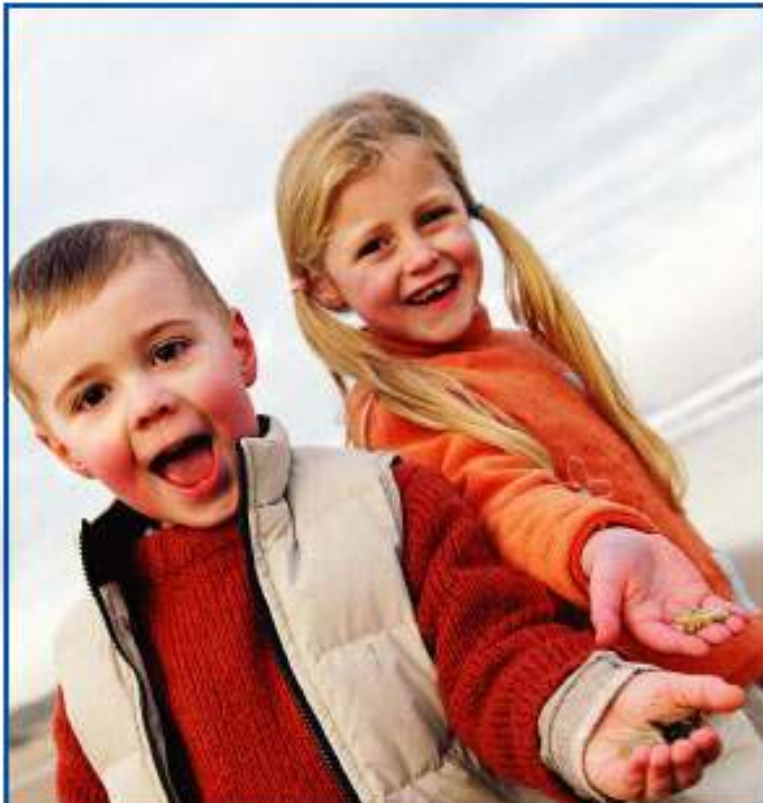
